AIA STATEN ISLAND COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The AIA SI College Scholarship Award recognizes outstanding students of the Staten Island community whose ambition and creative design thinking will positively influence the future of the architecture profession. Designed to promote the study and practice of architecture, engineering or construction (AEC), this award aims to encourage academic pursuits within these fields and helps to defray costs associated with higher education tuition.

Award

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be awarded annually, with the option to renew throughout the duration of the applicant's higher educational pursuits. Initial annual award and renewal of the award are at the discretion of the Chapter.

Requirements

Applicants are encouraged to provide as many of the below listed as possible:

- Be enrolled or intending to enroll in a Vocational or College Program focusing on architecture, engineering, construction, or related field
- Demonstrate an active interest and initial skills in the AEC fields
- Have proven record of providing meritorious service to the Staten Island community
- Demonstrate marked leadership in scholastic achievements
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Upon graduation, recipients will receive a one-year complimentary associate membership to the AIA SI Chapter. Recipients are expected to participate in Chapter events as well as the Emerging Professionals committee.

Submission*

Submissions must be in accordance with the guidelines below:

- One-page letter of nomination stating the candidate's career interests and contributions to the Staten Island community
- Two examples of creative work
- One-page personal essay describing experiences and interests in the AEC field
- Up to 2 recommendation letters: 1 academic reference letter and 1 personal reference letter (should speak to extracurricular activities, community contributions, character, etc)
- School transcript

AIA STATEN ISLAND HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The AIA SI High School Scholarship Award promotes and encourages the study and practice of architecture, engineering or construction as a future career and recognizes academic excellence and meritorious service to the Staten Island community by a Staten Island High School Senior.

Award

A one-time scholarship of \$1,000 to be awarded annually to a High School Senior at the discretion of the Chapter.

Requirements

Applicants are encouraged to provide as many of the below listed as possible:

- Have current enrollment in a Staten Island High School (applicants must be in their Senior year)
- Demonstrate an active interest and initial skills in the Architecture, Engineering, or Construction (AEC) fields
- Have proven record of providing meritorious service to the Staten Island community
- Demonstrate marked leadership in scholastic achievements

Submission*

Submissions must be in accordance with the guidelines below:

- One-page letter of nomination stating the candidate's career interests and contributions to the Staten Island community
- Portfolio of related work or Essay describing experiences and interests in the AEC field
- Up to 2 recommendation letters: 1 academic reference letter and 1 personal reference letter (should speak to extracurricular activities, community contributions, character, etc)
- School transcript
